Young Artists

Young Artists is a FREE pre-professional arts program in which twenty high school students (ages 14–18) meet over ten consecutive Saturday afternoons. Located in a vibrant and active contemporary art space, Young Artists introduces creative careers, explores contemporary culture, provides portfolio development, and fuels a curiosity about the arts! Participants attend workshops and training sessions designed to foster creative and critical thinking skills. This program is the prerequisite of Advanced Young Artists, an annual mentorship program that pairs ten teen artists with ten local artist-mentors. Join Young Artists and receive a behind-the-scenes view of the museum and art community through the lens of contemporary art!

- This program is FREE for accepted students. *Regular and on-time attendance is required.*
- Select spaces reserved for students from underserved areas with limited access to arts opportunities in Austin.
